So the snowpack is almost melted due to spring arriving. And yet [it is still snowing](#) all around us.

The lies and the falsehoods have been driving me deeper into prayer. Hopefully you are seeking renewal in prayer too. We are like most families as the family of God. We all have different ways we may see things, even different ways we pray. For some it is the Word of God. For others Gregorian chants. Others still, enjoy spontaneous prayer, the Rosary or a whole host of other prayers. Some of the family likes to pray alone, some in groups of 2 or 3 (Matthew 18:19-20) and others love to pray in community, although varied lockdowns can make this difficult.

Some of the family participates in Bible studies, worship services and a myriad of other ways to acknowledge God. I love the Mass. I try to participate every day in the Mass. I have been successful doing so this week. (That is not always true. ☺) Being silent during prayer, even when in community, is important. It is in the silence we can hear God and allow Him to hold us as His children.

On Thursday this past week, I attended the noon Mass at the beautiful Basilica of St. John in Des Moines. Within the Mass are two pearls for folks who are aware: the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist. What occurred that day was ... unbelievable, even to me. I initially thought that a construction company was doing work outside with air tools that were in bad shape. The sound seemed muffled. It seemed to begin at the Liturgy of the Word and continue to the end of the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Most of us like to know about the things that seem odd or out of place. I did some research. I sought out the sound. This is exactly what I heard: [THE SOUND](#). When Mass was completed, I checked outside. There was no construction company presence.

I have been known to tell tall tales to my children and grandchildren. I do not joke about God. I try to live life with honesty and integrity, I believe most of us do.

The sound I heard was most likely a shofar's blast. The shofar is a ram's horn that is hollowed out and used as a trumpet. It is used for many purposes in the Old Testament and to this day amongst our Jewish brethren. The first purpose I came across for a shofar was as an instrument of warfare, spiritual and physical. "Shofar blasts are sounded preceding a war - to rally the troops for action and to call the people together for prayer and repentance. The sound of the shofar is supposed to inspire fear in the hearts of those who hear it. It allows one to dwell upon fear of punishment, to progress from there to fear of doing evil and then to fear of God. Finally, one arrives at the feeling of awe of God." Let's all hope this Lenten season spent in prayer and fasting, leads us to repentance and renewal that results in awe of God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

Did anyone else hear the sound. I don't know. I did not ask. I left, walking in awe of God.

The first Patriotic Rosary for Region 7 that occurred on Tuesday, March 2, 2021 as a ZOOM event was a success in my books! Almost 50 people participated in person or online. Many people found it to be powerful (praying for every individual in every State of the Union) and humbling (realizing how many people were praying for you as an individual in your State). The Patriotic Rosary is normally prayed the first Tuesday of each month in Region 7. However, April 6, 2021 is already scheduled for Charlie Johnston to speak within Region 7. The next Region 7 Patriotic Rosary will occur on May 4. We hope to continue with a ZOOM link.

The Membership Meeting for Region 7 was ... let me just say "Old Scratch" doesn't like us trying to move forward with the next right step. The technical difficulties that occurred were laughable. But we adapted and moved on. I believe those who were able to join us for the meeting still received the information they came for. Currently Region 7 Membership Meetings occur the first Thursday of each month. However, April 1, 2021 is Holy Thursday. I am working on getting it rescheduled. The good news is we will be adding another Membership meeting on a different night too! I will keep you posted.




