Camp on the Property

For those traveling a distance, please feel free to camp on the property.

There is plenty of room and we are a short walking distance to the Wisconsin River where it meets the Pine River for recreation should you wish.

Other options for travelers are local AIRBNB's as well as hotels in Richland Center, WI, Ramada by Wyndham, about 10 miles and Spring Green, WI., The Usonian Inn or Spring Valley Inn. Both are about 10 miles.

St Mary's, Pine Bluff, Fr. Heilman's church, although he'll be leaving end of June. It is a beautiful church and a good priest is taking over. Mass times: 7:30am, 9:15am and 10:45am. It is approximately 40 minutes from farm.
